
# **MN Agricultural Rankings**

  - #5 in mink pelts




# U.S. Top 10 States: Crops

(Billion \$)




# Minnesota Crop & Livestock Production

(%-share by value)




### Minnesota Agricultural Marketing

(%-share by cash receipts)




# **U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture**

(Billion \$)




### U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock

 Population: 5.5 million – ranks 21st in the U.S. (Rural: 23%; urban: 77%)

 Farm land: 26 million acres (51% of total land area)

Number of farms: 73,000Average farm size: 355 acres

Agricultural marketing: \$16.8 billion (2016)


Crops: \$9.7 billionLivestock: \$7.1 billion

 National ranking: 4th largest agricultural exporting state in the U.S.


 2016 agricultural exports: \$7.13 billion (nearly onethird of the state's total merchandise exports)

### MN Ag Exports: #1 in State's All Industries




# **Minnesota Ag Export by Commodity**

(%-share by value)




